**Re: Annual General Meeting -
Compensation for the Playmaker Program**

During the AGM a question was tabled by a member regarding whether or not an honorarium of \$2,000 was paid to the Playmaker Program Co-ordinator. The Treasurer responded by indicating that this was not the case. However the discussion that followed left some members confused.

The following has been provided for clarity:

- Under the guidance of Rosemary Lucas - Harden, the Playmaker Program has grown to be one of the most successful adult activities. Rosemary has administered this program for numerous years and throughout her tenure has never asked for and never received funds from the Club to offset any expenses or her time spent managing the program. Rosemary is a valued volunteer who believes wholeheartedly in our Badminton community. She is clearly one who gives more than she receives.
- The Badminton Club Executive Committee reviewed this issue at the Executive Meeting of June 28. Our goal was to gain a better understanding as to why the issue was even raised. As a result, we uncovered that a proposal had been made by a previous executive member to set aside up to \$ 2,000 to support the Playmaker Program. This proposal was never approved and therefore never actioned.
